Evergreen House

Evergreen House is a beautiful Victorian home with views overlooking the Halifax Harbour. Judge Alexander James built it in 1867. It has been host to many a visit from the famous Joseph Howe, as the Judge and Howe were known friends. Evergreen House was also the home to nationally acclaimed Nova Scotian folklorist, Dr. Helen Creighton.

It has two rooms available year-round for private and corporate functions. Both rooms overlook Halifax Harbour and provide splendid views of the Dartmouth shoreline.

Private function rate is \$20.00/hour. Corporate rate is \$30.00/hour. Not-for-profit rate is \$15.00/hour. After hours bookings available on a case-by-case basis and rate is assessed based on accommodation required.

The Green Parlour

The Green Parlour is located on the main level. The room is bright with windows overlooking Halifax Harbour and the lovely backyard. It is an ideal space for small, intimate gatherings by the Harbour. The attached sunporch space is also available to rent for an additional fee.



The Meeting Room

The Meeting Room is located on the lower level. The room is suited for your meeting needs. It is conveniently located next to our full kitchen. It has a private side entrance.



Both rooms can accommodate approximately 25 people, seated with tables.

Available amenities include tables, chairs, linens, teaware, and cutlery. Your guests are welcome to visit our permanent and temporary exhibits at the Museum during your event. The serving of alcohol is prohibited. Food/beverage is only permitted in the Green Parlour and the Meeting Room. There is a washroom located on the main floor by the entrance. No fresh flowers permitted in the Museum.

Quaker House

Is open seasonally, from June through August. It is also available to rent during this period. Please contact us for details.
